Description / Challenge / Initial Situation:

The Sustainability Regulation Expert Group within Catena-X e.V. is dedicated to monitoring regulatory developments, legislation, standardization and other relevant initiatives in the field of sustainability for the automotive industry.

As for now, the DPP Regulations Expert Group will **focus exclusively on Digital Product Passports (DPP)** as the initial and sole topic for its mandate. Other sustainability regulations will be considered **out of scope for this phase** and may be addressed in future extensions once a robust DPP foundation is established.

The group's primary focus is to transfer all available DPP regulations into a practical overview according to a defined framework which gets defined by the group.

While EU regulation (e.g. ESPR and related initiatives) remains an important reference point, the group's primary challenge and priority is the international dimension of Digital Product Passports. The expert group therefore explicitly seeks expertise on:

- Non-EU regulatory frameworks and initiatives (e.g. Asia, North America, international trade requirements)
- Global standards and standardization bodies relevant to DPP
- Cross-border interoperability and alignment challenges for Digital Product Passports

Goals:

The group will establish a **globally oriented regulatory and standards overview for Digital Product Passports**.

The mandate of the group includes:

- Overview on status: Creating a basis including national, European and global regulations, legislations and standards on DPPs. The overview should be as comprehensively as possible – there is no guarantee of completeness though.
- Regular updates: An update mechanism for the overview above should be created based on a strategic monitoring solution. The updates will be reviewed and worked into the overview.

The mandate does not include:

- Legal consultation
- Answering to individual and company specific requests

By fulfilling this mandate, the group plays a crucial role in addressing regulatory complexity and facilitating the sustainable transformation of the automotive value chain. It ensures that Catena-X remains at the forefront of compliance and standardization while fostering technological innovation and collaboration. By expanding the scope to a global regulatory landscape, it fosters the

internationalization of Catena-X and helps members to track and oversee upcoming DPP related requirements.

Rough planning – Milestones / Outcome / Deliverables (e.g., “Date & Activities & Outcome”):

January 2026:	Announcement, re-application phase and confirmation of the members
May 2026:	Overview on status of international DPP regulations established
October 2026:	Regular update mechanism is in place
November 2026:	First further regulations for enhancement identified
December 2026:	Work plan for 2027
